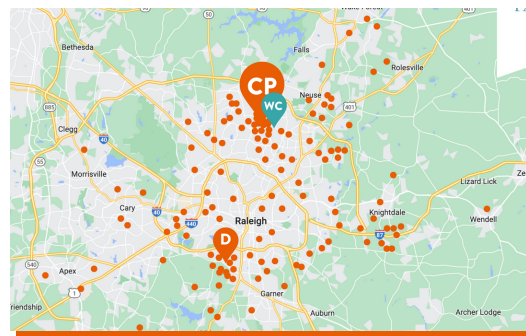

Our biggest milestone of 2022 was the opening of our first Welcome Center. Since then, relationships have flourished and families have thrived as we've served 30% more refugees in this space. Our Welcome Center has become a place of community, hospitality, and love - a place for us to embrace what it means to be a neighbor.

Through expanded programming in Citizenship, English Learning, Budgeting & Finance, Home Buying, Health & Parenting, and Career Development, the Welcome Center has enabled us to serve more refugee families through easily-accessible, supportive programming while we focus more intensive help on those living at multi-family housing locations.
